1. All entries must be made with the show secretary, Jean Homer, R.R. 4, Fergus, ON. N1M 2W5, by Friday, September 9, 2011. A **75-cent entry** fee applies to each entry and must accompany entry form
2. When making entries please put: A for cock, B for hen, C for cockerel, and D for pullet.
3. All entries (which must be pre-registered) must be placed in the Recreation Centre Shed from 7:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on Friday, September 16, 2011.
4. The association will take all precautions to ensure the safety and welfare of the birds, but will not be responsible for loss or damage whatsoever. Entries are at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
5. Judging will take place Saturday, September 17, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. The newly revised Standard of Perfection shall be the guide for all judging. The judge's decision will be final.
6. Prizes not awarded unless deemed worthy by the judge.
7. Any bird showing signs of illness will be removed from the showroom.
8. Only two birds per section (e.g. 2 cocks, 2 hens, 2 cockerels, 2 pullets – total 8)
All birds are to remain cooped until 4:00 p.m. Sunday,
September 18, 2011.
